Resolution No. 14 ESTABLISHING A 2023-24 FISCAL YEAR NON-RESIDENT TUITION FEE PURSUANT **TO EDUCATION CODE SECTIONS 76140**

WHEREAS, Education Code Section 76140 states that a non-resident fee shall be set by the governing board of each community college district not later than March first of each year; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Board of Trustees of the Santa Barbara Community College District's Board of Trustees to require payment of the prescribed fee for all non-resident students except those who are full-time employees of the Santa Barbara Community College District and for the spouses and children of full-time employees of the District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Santa Barbara Community College District's Board of Trustees, pursuant to Education Code Sections 76140, hereby establishes for Fall 2021 a per-unit non-resident tuition fee of \$351 and capital outlay fee of \$22 for a total tuition fee of \$373.
